**Mayflower 400th Anniversary**

**The Year 2020 marks the 400th anniversary of the sailing of the Mayflower.**

More than 30 million people can trace their ancestry to the 102 passengers and approximately 30 crew who sailed on the Mayflower for a new life in the New World. In September of 1620 this group of people, who would become known as the Pilgrims, left their final stop in Plymouth to seek freedom to practice their religion and opportunity across the Atlantic. In the process many believe they laid the foundations for modern America.

We will visit the site where the Mayflower departed on her epic voyage and will explore some of the highlights of old town Plymouth.



**Plymouth**

Our accommodations are in an historic grand hotel dating from 1863, created to serve a growing demand for luxury accommodation in the early days of steam. It welcomed a busy flow of passengers arriving by rail and ocean liners. With its imposing Gothic building style, grand rooms with ornate interior details, and stunning sweeping staircase, it has welcomed many illustrious visitors including explorer, Ernst Shackleton, and his party who stayed here the night before departing on their famous Antarctic expedition in 1914.
