


Travel Bug Tour Connections

A wild, unspoilt and exhilarating place to visit, sitting as it does on the Wild Atlantic Way, a huge coastal touring route that covers 9 counties.

The area really does have everything, from expanses of wilderness, majestic mountains and breathtaking waterfalls to stunning sandy beaches and even ancient woodlands where Ireland's only herd of wild Red Deer can be found. We will take you on a trip to uncover some of its treasures and experience a culture famed for its myths, legends and music.

We will be based in a 4-star hotel in the historic town of Killarney on the shores of Lough Leane and the very edge of Killarney National Park. Steeped in history, our walks will take in a 15th century abbey and castle and a stone fort said to be one of the three oldest buildings in the the country, as well as an unsurpassed variety of natural beauty.

The route will vary in difficulty with walking distances between 3 – 10 miles and elevation gains up to 2500 feet. The terrain is varied; from quiet country lanes to uneven rocky trails, mountain paths and board-walks. Some sections will be steep and others will be boggy and some agility will be needed to climb stiles.
